General required documents for an Estonia Visa Application:

- <u>Download the application form</u>, fill it completely and with sincerity. You can also fill the Estonia Schengen Visa application form electronically and then print a hard-copy. Learn <u>how to fill-in the Estonian Visa</u> application form!
- 2 photos must be attached; the photo should be of passport format a recent whole-face capture with a light background. Learn more about photo requirements and specifications for an Estonian Visa.
- Your passport and copies of your previous visas valid for at least 3 months beyond return date are required. Your passport must have at least two blank pages.
- <u>Travel medical insurance</u> confirmation of minimum 30,000 € coverage within Estonia and the entire Schengen area
- A cover letter stating the purpose of visit to Estonia and itinerary
- A copy of your return-ticket reservation with dates and flight numbers specifying entry and exit from Estonia. It is not recommended to purchase the ticket before obtaining the visa – if not otherwise required. Learn how to book a round trip reservation online!
- Proof of Accommodation for the whole duration of the intended stay in Estonia. Learn <u>how to get Hotel</u> booking or reservation for Estonian Visa application.
- Proof of civil status (marriage certificate, birth certificate of children, death certificate of spouse, ration card if applicable)
- Means of subsistence Proof of sufficient financial means for the period of stay in Estonia. The amount of financial means that every foreigner applying for an Estonian Visa has to demonstrate owning to the Estonian Embassy or Consulate, is 600 EEK or 38.35€ /day for the period of stay in Estonia.

If employed:

- Employment contract
- Current bank statement of the latest 6 months
- No-objection letter from employer
- Income Tax Return (ITR) form or Certificate of Income Tax deducted at the source of salary

If self-employed:

- A copy of your business license
- Company bank statement of the latest 6 months
- Income Tax Return (ITR)

If a student:

- Proof of enrollment
- No-objection certificate from school or university

If retired:

Pension statement of the latest 6 months

If applicable:

Regular income generated by property proof of the latest 6 months

*Note: The signed application form must be accompanied the rest of the above-mentioned mandatory documents and handed personally at the appropriate embassy/consulate or its representative in your home country.

List of additional documents required for the most frequent purposes of Estonia Visa Application:

Estonia Tourist/Visitor Visa:

- <u>Invitation letter from your family or friends in Estonia</u> with the address and phone number if applicable
- Bank statement of the last 6 months
- Passport copies
