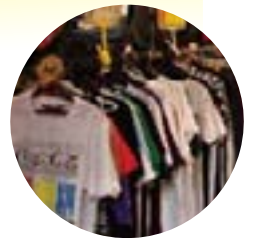

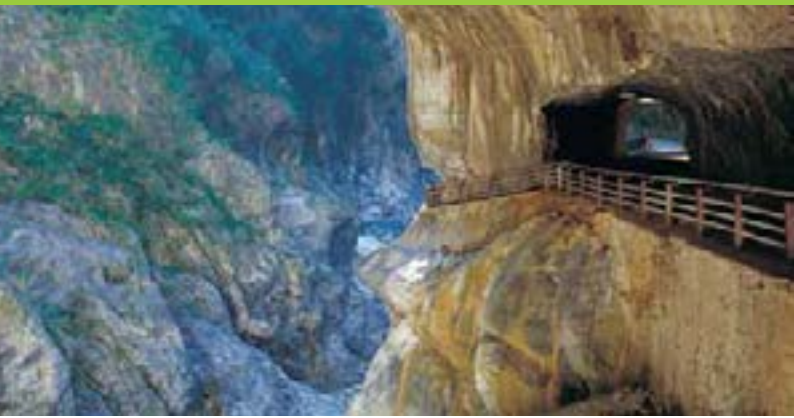

貓村：以貓為主題的村落，整個村子收養了整百隻的貓，讓愛貓的人喜歡來此朝聖，台鐵車站也相當配合的將整體包裝成貓村車站。

九份：曾經是挖金礦後的廢棄山城，因電影<悲情城市>而再度繁華，成為台灣最熱鬧最長的一條老街。

高美濕地：台中最美海岸風景區，除了溼地生態豐富外，並可欣賞整排風力發電風車，為之壯觀。

逢甲夜市：是全台灣最大且著名的觀光夜市，逢甲夜市的消費以『便宜又大碗』為最吸引各路愛好夜市的民眾。

世界花卉博覽會期間：花博會的理念是在追求生產的過程中，尊重并珍惜土地及所有生物，以創造更有價值、更加幸福的生活，重新詮釋具有溫度的GNP(Green綠色、Nature自然、People人文)。

第三天 台中 / 南投 / 高雄 (早/午)

日月潭風景區：全台最大淡水湖泊，四周群巒疊翠，山水相映的景致相當美麗，南形如月弧，北形如日輪，所以名為『日月潭』，是古今中外遊客來台必訪景點。

黃金菠蘿城堡：為台灣第一名鳳梨酥觀光工廠，外觀如童話世界的城堡，以科技方式來呈現鳳梨的成長及鳳梨酥的製作過程，並有些許科技互動遊戲，是一處大人小孩都適合參觀之幸福城堡。

哈瑪星輕軌：高雄最新的大眾交通運輸工具-輕軌，以哈瑪星車站為起點，沿途經過高雄港沿岸建築。

佛陀紀念館~國立海洋生物博物館~海角七號白沙灣~墾丁大街~墾丁渡假村

佛陀紀念館：佛陀紀念館為供奉佛祖的舍利子而建，是一座融合古今與中外、傳統與現代的建築，具有文化與教育、慧解與修持的功能，主館上方為世界最高108米佛像，館內並有全世界第一間素食Starbucks。

國立海洋生物博物館：總面積廣達96.81公頃，主要以展現「水」的精神與特性為主。館內規劃區域有台灣水域、珊瑚王國、世界水域三大主題展示館、珊瑚王國館長達84公尺的「海底隧道」穿梭於150萬加侖的巨型人造海洋中，體驗絢爛多采的珊瑚世界，世界水域館則運用高科技4D呈現古代水底世界。

白沙灣：為墾丁國家公園內多處沙灘之一的白沙灘，亦是海角七號電影重要拍攝場景。

墾丁大街：墾丁大街到了夜晚就成了全墾丁人潮最多的地方。

第五天 墾丁 / 嘉義 (早/午)

安平老街：有『台灣第一街』之稱，台灣最古老的老街，街道兩旁聚集了許多特色店家，柑仔店、古早味童玩小吃店還有百年的蜜餞店鹹酸甜，並有相當多台南小吃可品嚐。

安平古堡：古代時期也被稱為“台灣城”的堡壘，是台灣第一座城堡。被列為第一級古蹟。

檜意森活村：將舊日式紅檜木建築官舍整修後從新開張，為目前台灣最大檜木建築聚落，現場進駐了非常多之文創商店，並有店家提供和服出租照相。

文化路夜市：夜市中許多道地小吃，知名的嘉義雞肉飯是遊客必點美食。

第六天 嘉義 / 台北 (早/午)

忠烈祠：紀念為國犧牲的烈士。大門前站崗的衛兵，不動如山，酷似雕像，交接班哨儀式會表演耍槍，常聚集眾多遊客駐足觀看，蔚為特色。

台北101：台灣第一高樓，總高度達508公尺，融合現代藝術及中國風水的特色建築，內有世界各地名牌商品。

五分埔：近一千家的成衣業者在此匯集，以貨源來自全省及港、泰、韓、新各地，流行且物美價廉的服飾批發、零售，吸引不少愛美一族來此採購。

饒河觀光夜市：台北知名觀光夜市，兩側商店及騎樓下的攤販不計其數。

第七天 台北 / 甜蜜的家 (早)

Head to the **Cat Village**, so named due to its huge population of adopted cats, as well as its themed decorations. The entire village is bursting with felines, and those who enjoy these cute critters will have a blast. Then, check out **Jiufen Street**, a once-abandoned mining town that diminished in popularity after the gold rush. When the hit movie "City of Sadness" was filmed here, fans and visitors flocked to the town, transforming it into one of the liveliest areas in Taiwan. After this, head to the **Gaomei Wetlands**, where you can catch the most beautiful coastal view in Taichung. In addition to the rich ecology of the area, visitors can also see the long line of wind turbines built there, creating an amazing sight. **Fengjia Night Market** is your next stop. It is the liveliest and largest night market in Taiwan, and features an almost unlimited array of local delights and street snacks. The market is known for its big portions and low prices, which entices tourists year round.

In the morning, catch a glimpse of the **Sun Moon Lake**, so named because one side of the lake is a crescent shape, whereas the other is circular, just like the sun and moon. It is one of the most beautiful lakes in Taiwan. Just east of the lake is the **Formosan Aboriginal Culture Village**, a theme park where you can see a devoted recreation of an indigenous village. Visit **Golden Vigor Castle** next. It is the first Pineapple Cake sightseeing factory in Taiwan, and is built and styled to resemble a fairytale castle. It uses cutting edge technology to simulate and present the growth of pineapples as well as the process of creating Pineapple cake. Afterward, head to the **Hamaxing Light Rail**, Kaohsiung's newest public transport method. The rail starts from Hama Station and passes along the port.



DAY 4 KAOHSIUNG / KENTING (B/L)

Hotel: Kentington Resort or similar

Buddha Memorial Center ~ National Museum of Marine Biology & Aquarium ~ White Sand Bay Beach ~ Kenting Streets ~ Kenting Resort

Visit the **Buddha Memorial Center**, built to worship the relics of the Buddha. Its construction combined both Chinese and Foreign architectural techniques and skills. The main statue towers at an impressive 108 meters high, and is the tallest such statue in the world. In the square, you can also find the world's first vegetarian Starbucks. After the temple visit, head to the **National Museum of Marine Biology**, which also fittingly features its own aquarium. Occupying a total area of 96.81 hectares, the museum showcases the many facets of Water as a concept, and is home to three themed exhibits, with an underwater tunnel as one of its highlights. Then, head to the **White Sand Bay Beach**, one of the most dazzling white sand beaches, within the **Kenting National Park**. One fact of note is that it was also the filming location for the Cape No. 7 film.

DAY 5 KENTING / CHIAYI (B/L)

Hotel: Look Royal Hotel or similar

Ten Drum Culture Village ~ Drumming experience ~ Anping Old Street ~ Anping Old Fort ~ Forest Railway Story House Hinoki Village ~ Wenhua Night Market

Head to the **Anping Old Street**, one of the oldest streets in Taiwan. It has been nicknamed "The First Street In Taiwan", is lined with many local specialty stores as well as grocery shops, toyshops and snack bars. **Anping Old Fort**, also known as Fort Zeelandia, was a fortress that took almost 10 years to construct and was built by the Dutch East India Company in 1624. It is the first castle in Taiwan, and is considered one of the grandest tourist sites in the country. After visiting the Fort, head to **Hinoki Village**, with its collection of buildings crafted with red cypresswood. The village was opened for official residence after its renovation, and has become Taiwan's largest cypress settlement, as well as a little slice of Japan in Taiwan. Check out the **Wenhua Night Market** after nightfall, where you can find vendors that offer a huge variety of goods, ranging from fashion to local food.

DAY 6 CHIAYI / TAIPEI (B/L)

Hotel: Papa Whale or similar

Bullet train experience ~ Martyrs ~ Taipei 101 (Observatory fee own expenses) ~ Jimmy Bus ~ Wufenpu ~ Raohe Night Market

In the morning, visit a **Martyr Memorial** where you can observe a monument dedicated to those that have sacrificed themselves for the country. The soldiers guarding the monument stay silent and still, out of immense respect. **Taipei 101** will be your next stop. Considered a world-famous location, it is one of the tallest buildings in the world, standing at an impressive 508 meters. Within the structure is a mall, where you can shop to your hearts delight. Then, check out **Wufenpu**, where nearly a thousand garment shops have been gathered, from almost every province and even other countries, such as Korea, Hong Kong and Thailand. Then, visit the **Raohe Street Tourist Night Market**, where you can enjoy the bustling atmosphere of Taiwanese night-life, and indulge in local food.

The **Luodong Night Market** is one of the biggest and most exciting night markets in Ilan, containing a huge variety of local delicacies.

Known widely for its spectacular mountains and marble canyons, locals have termed its features “Treasures of Heaven and Earth”. The **Swallow Grotto of Taroko Park** is especially outstanding, featuring marble cliff faces, dotted with Swallow and Swift nests. Also in the park, is the **Shakadang Trail**, a beautiful, small trail where you can peek across at mountains and canyons. The Raohe Night market spans an impressive 600 meters in length and is lined from start to finish in local stalls selling all sorts of local snacks, crafts and even art.

It is unique for being the only temple in Taiwan that contains a statue of Confucius, as well as one of it's defining features, the "Year Of Steps at Wunwu Temple".

The **Sun Moon Lake** is Taiwan's largest lake. Its east side is round like the sun, whereas its west side is long and narrow, like the moon, inspiring its name. One of the most beautiful natural landmarks in Taiwan, its sights and sounds are not to be missed. The **Xuanguang Temple** is a temple in Taiwan, with relics within that once belonged to the monk **Xuanzhang of the Tang Dynasty**. Of special note are the myriads of street performers around the temple, as well as the famous tea-boiled eggs sold at a legendary store outside the temple. The **Granny** who owns the stall has perfected her recipe over 50 years, and now gets thousands of customers each day. The **Qingjing farm** is a famous farm in Taiwan, located at a high altitude; the farm is blanketed in a layer of fog, earning it the name "Foggy Eden" after the biblical paradise. The farm is home to rolling plains as well as gorgeous scenery and fresh,

clean air. Animals can be seen roaming the vast plains, and visitors are able to interact with them, making it a wholesome, enjoyable experience.

The **Liuhe night market** is one of Taiwan's premiere night markets. Known for its especially fresh seafood, as well as its variety of delicacies, prepare to breathe in the delightful scent of seafood on the grill, and have a little taste of the delights the market has to offer.

Head for **Shennong Street** in the morning. This is an emerging district in Tainan, and features a considerable amount of cultural flair, as well as art. Head to the **Sun Moon Lake** in the foothills of Taiwan's central mountain range. The Lake is considered one of the most beautiful sites in Taiwan, and has held this title for over a hundred years. Our next stop is **Jiufen**, a once-abandoned mining town that was revitalized after the movie "City of Sadness" was filmed there. Fans and visitors flocked to the area, and transformed it into one of the most bustling locations in Taiwan, filled to the brim with teahouses, eateries and shops. Next, check out **Taroko National Park**, famous for its mountains and marble canyons, formed after years of rushing water cut straight through the marble and granite cliffs. Of special note is **the Swallow Grotto**, where years of erosion have created tiny holes in the cliff faces, which became nests for a huge number of Swallows. Then, take a trip to the **Eternal Spring Shrine**, built in 1958 to commemorate the 212 workers that perished during the construction of the cross-island highway. It was built into the side of a mountain, and thus, when water flows down from above, it looks akin to water pouring from the heavens above, a beautiful sight.

DAY 3 HUALIAN / TAITUNG (B/L/D)

Hotel: *Taitung Hotel or similar*

Chihsing Tan Scenic Area ~ Farglory Ocean Park ~ Tropic of Cancer ~ Water Goes Up ~ Hot Spring

On this day, we head to the **ChiHsingTan Scenic Area**, where you can watch the calming waves and gaze at the great green mountains from afar. The beautiful white sand and the morning air further enhance the atmosphere, letting you experience an authentic connection with nature. Then, head to the **Farglory Ocean Park**, a famous marine park located in **Hualien**, with the distinction of being the first marine-biology focused amusement park. The park features **8 unique zones** that each cover a different aspect of marine life, and contains a wide variety of



shows and rides that are sure to titillate both adults and children alike. Then, head for the **Tropic of Cancer**, the Northern Hemisphere's furthest location from the Equator. Meinong Hakka Village ~ Fo Guang Shan ~ Xinjujiang Night Market

Head to the **MeiNong Hakka Village** and check out the **MeiNong Cultural Museum**, designated as a local landmark. It has an important mission to preserve Hakka culture and heritage, and there, locals can learn about the struggles of the early Hakka and their traditional values and virtues. Then, head to **Fo Guang Shan**, a monastery established by master Hsing Yun. The Master presented a tooth relic of the Buddha to the temple, in the hopes that those coming to worship the relic will be prompted to learn more about the precepts of Buddhism and thus immerse themselves in Buddhist way. The temple was thus grandly built as a symbol of worship, and features a huge golden statue of Buddha, measuring in at some 120 meters, a sight to behold. Then, head to the **Xinjujiang Night Market**, where fashion, recreation, shopping and dining collide, creating a multi-faceted shopping experience for locals and tourists alike. This has made the area one of the premiere shopping destinations in Kaohsiung, and it is constantly growing in size.

DAY 5 KAOHSIUNG / CHIAYI (B/L/D)

Alishan Forest Park is your first stop of the day, featuring a beautiful view of the sunrise as well as the clouds and ocean. The clouds there are so dense that the mountaintops appear like islands on the ocean. Check out the **Ziyun Temple**, **Alishan Hotel** and the **Alishan rail station** also in the area.

DAY 6 CHIAYI / TAICHUNG (B/L)

Sun Moon Lake ~ Wenwu Temple Observation Deck ~ Fengjia Night Market

Visit the **Sun Moon Lake**, located in the foothills of Taiwan's Central Mountain Range. Considered one of the most beautiful sights in all of Taiwan, it has held this moniker for over 100 years. Its majestic name comes from the shape of the two sides of the lake, being part crescent and park circular, reminiscent of the moon and sun respectively. Next, visit the **WenWu Temple**, dedicated to the Civilian saint Confucius and the Military saint Guan Gong. This has made it popular amongst students wishing for good grades, and parents worried for their children. It claims to be the largest night market in the country, and its sprawling size definitely backs this up, featuring a huge number of stalls that sell everything from local delights to clothes.

You are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following terms and conditions (collectively called the Service Assurance Policy). For purposes of clarity, shall be referred to as "The Company" in this Policy.

1. Commitment to Service Quality Excellence

•We adopt a mindset of quality excellence and innovation so that our level of service to our Customers will continually be enhanced.
•We provide reliable services that meet or exceed expectations of our Customers.

•We ensure that the services we provide are of satisfactory quality as defined in the Sales of Goods Act S14 (2), Consumer Protection (Fair Trading) Act and Lemon Law.

2. Professional Ethics

The Company adopts fair and ethical business practices as well as accurate marketing communications at all times.

3. Reservation, Deposit and Full Payment

•Reservations can be made by you anytime during business opening hours.

Tour

•A deposit of 50% of the total tour fare is required upon reservation.
•Payment of deposit does not constitute the confirmation of the tour. All group packages are subjected to a minimum group size (as determined by the company) in order for confirmation to take effect and for the departure date to be finalized.

•Full payment is required not less than 14 days prior to departure.

•If full payment is not received 14 days or less prior to departure, the company reserves the right to forfeit the deposit and cancel the reservation.

Air Tickets

A non-refundable deposit, whose amount, will depend on the type of air ticket purchased and the airline chosen, is required for the reservation of air tickets. This will be made known at the time of purchase and a receipt will be issued for this deposit and the balance indicated to be paid within the stipulated period.

Group Tickets

A non-refundable deposit, whose amount, will depend on the type of air ticket purchased and the airline chosen, is required for the reservation of group tickets. This will be made known at the time of purchase and a receipt will be issued for this deposit and the balance indicated to be paid within the stipulated period. The materialization for this group will also be indicated for the agreed price.

4. Cancellation on By The Customer –

Customers are allowed to cancel the reservation in writing, at any time prior to the departure date. However, cancellation fees will apply and the cancellation fee is computed based on the length of notice period prior to the departure date. Please note that the cancellation fee is a percentage of the total tour fare.

The cancellation charges as well as corresponding refund component are indicated below:

Cancellation Notice	Cancellation Fee per Person (percentage of total tour fare)
From the time of booking to: Upon Customer's Confirmation	30%
Less than 21 days prior to departure	50%
Less than 14 days prior to departure	75%
Less than 07 days prior to departure	100%

Customer shall receive the refund (for payment made by cash and cheque), if applicable, not later than 14 working days upon the company receiving the written notice of cancellation and when no documents have been issued prior to the cancellation notice.

However, when documents have been issued, prior to the cancellation notice, all refund, if applicable, to the customer will be made not later than after 30 working days or subject to the time taken by the Third Party or Credit Card Company to process the non-cash or cheque refund. Where packages are non-refundable, this will be made known to the customer at the time of purchase.

5. Cancellation By The Company

Please note that the Company is acting as an agent for services rendered. Even after deposit or full payment has been made, all arrangements are still subject to final confirmation. If for some unforeseeable circumstances the arrangement cannot be finalized and the tour reservation has to be cancelled, the Company will endeavour to notify the Customer at least one (1) week before departure date. The Company also reserves the right to cancel any tour prior to the date of departure for whatever reason including, but not limited to, insufficient number of participants. Should any of the above happen, the entire payment shall be refunded to the Customer without further obligation on the part of the company. The Company may however, recommend alternative tours to the same or some other destinations. Should the Customer decide not to accept the alternatives, all monies paid shall be refunded in full by the Company without further obligations.

The Company shall also not be held liable for any contingent costs incurred by the Customer arising from the cancellation.

Customer shall receive the refund not later than 7 working days upon the company notifying the Customer of the tour cancellation.

6. Cancellation By Third Parties

There will be a administration fee of S\$100 charge per person for cancellation due to closure of facilities by local government, closure of airports, non-availability of specific tourist destinations and itinerary disruption due to natural disasters.

However, cancellation fee will not apply if Customer transfers the booking to an alternative destination or decides to postpone the trip to a later date. Any difference in the new fee due to the change shall be borne by the customer. The trip that has been postponed to another date shall be made within 12 months from the cancellation notification date.

7. Refund Policy on Used Portion

Tour
No refund or exchange can be made for any unused portion of the tour or flight.

Air Ticket

Any refund will depend on the type of ticket purchased and the airlines' term and conditions. This will be stipulated on the ticket and made known to the customer at the time of purchase. There will be a Service Charge of S\$100.

8. Refund Policy – Payment Mode

Please note that all refunds shall be made out in the original form of payment except for NETS.

For customers who paid by NETS, refund will be made out by cheque less a 1% NETS processing charge payable by the customer. Refund for payment made by credit card can only be made after 30 working days with a credit to the Credit Card account. If customer requests for cheque refund instead of a credit to the credit card account, there will be a service charge of 3% of amount paid, payable by the customer.

In summary, all refund shall be made out in the form of cheque (in

cases of payment made by cash or cheque) or a credit to the credit card account, in the case of payment made by credit card.

9. Amendment to Reservations and Amendment Fees Amendment to Tour Itinerary

Customers may wish to amend specific components, where applicable, within the Tour Itinerary (for example, upgrading of hotels, signing up for optional tour itineraries etc). All requests for amendments must be made in writing within 7 days upon customer's confirmation to the Tour package. The Company will revert to the Customer within 5 working days upon receiving written notice of the request for amendment.

Amendment Fee

The Company reserves the right to charge an amendment fee of S\$0 per person for each amendment requested for by the Customer. This fee will exclude all other charges imposed by the Airlines/Suppliers.

10. Extension of Stay/Deviation from Tour Itinerary

Extension of stay/deviation from tour itinerary may be permitted at the end of the tour, subject to a maximum validity and restrictions of air ticket seat confirmation, airlines' terms and conditions and availability of hotel prior to commencement of tour. It is the Customer's responsibility to hold firm confirmation for the return flight. When extension of stay/deviation from tour itinerary cannot be confirmed 3 weeks prior to the group departure date, Customer is deemed to be taking the original tour schedule. All extra costs incurred to process the extension/deviation, for example, administrative fees, will be borne by the Customer.

Extension of stay/deviation from tour itinerary will be at Customer's own expense and transfer to airport will not be provided.

The air ticket issued is a special ticket, restricted to a specific airline only. It is non-negotiable, non-endorsable, non-re-issuable, non-refundable and non-eroutable. Any alteration in routing or dates by the Customer is at his/her own risk. The Company and its associated agent shall not be held responsible for any inconvenience caused and extra expense incurred. No refund will be made for any unused air ticket, accommodation, meals or sightseeing, in part or in full.

11. Travel Documents, Travel Insurance and Travel Vouchers

Travel Documents

It is the Customer's responsibility to ensure that his/her international passport has a validity of at least 6 months from the date of departure. Relevant visas and vaccinations may be required. Cancellation fees apply for any cancellation due to non-approval of visas or other reasons as stated above. Singapore permanent residents are to bring along a valid exit permit when travelling. For foreign passport holders, it is the Customer's responsibility to hold valid re-entry visas.

The Company shall, whenever possible, assist the Customer in obtaining the necessary visas. Service and visa fees will be borne by the Customer. The Company does not guarantee the approval of the visa application. If for some reason, application for visa or exit permit is rejected, the Customer must notify the Company at least 30 days prior to the departure date. Administrative fees will apply. If notification is less than 30 days, the relevant cancellation charge as stated above will apply.

The Company cannot be held responsible for any expenses, reimbursement or refund of any tour fare if Customer is refused entry by any country on the tour for whatever reasons including lack of necessary visas/documentation.

Travel vouchers, if and when issued will be subject to terms and conditions stated for redemption purposes.

Travel Insurance

Purchase of travel insurance is strongly recommended with respect to unforeseen circumstances such as trip/tour cancellation, curtailment, personal baggage loss, personal accident, injury, illness, medical/hospitalization, flight delay, theft and other insurance coverage deemed necessary by the customer. Under no circumstances shall the Company be construed as a carrier under contract for safe carriage of Customer or his/her baggage/belongings. The Company's representative will be pleased to assist in the enquiries of any travel insurance and related matters.

12. General Matters relating to Tours

Accommodation

In the event the accommodation booked or requested for is not available, every effort will be made for an alternative in another accommodation of similar standard. This is subject to confirmation and availability. If the preferred hotel is not available, the customer is required to pay the difference if the alternative hotel booked is of a higher price.

Special Requests

If there are any requests regarding special meals, dietary requirements, adjoining rooms and so on, please inform the Company when making a reservation. Such requests are subject to confirmation and availability.

Seat Rotation

For the convenience of all members of the group, Customers are requested to rotate their seating arrangements on the coach during the period of the tour. Please cooperate when called upon to do so by the tour leader/guide.

Purchase During Tour

It is the responsibilities of customer for all personal goods purchased during the tour. The company is not responsible to request for refund on behalf of the customer.

13. Pricing Policies

The Company ensures accuracy in all its pricing policies.

Tour Fare for Group Tours Only

Tour fares are based on current airfares, service prices, government tax and exchange rates, applicable at time of print or quotation and are subject to change with or without prior notice.

Tour fare includes:

- Return economy class group tour air ticket.
- Return airport transfers (airport/hotel/airport).
- Hotel accommodation on twin-share basis.
- All meals, where applicable, as specified in the itinerary. If selected carrier's flight time does not allow for certain meals to be taken, there shall not be any refund for meals not consumed.
- Baggage allowance as stipulated by the airline.

Please note the following:

- When booking tripe-share rooms, the third bed may be a "roll-away" bed.
- Single room occupancy is at additional cost.

Tour prices are for payments specifically indicated in the

tour/booking form. The tour price excludes: -

- a. Airport Taxes
 - b. Visa Fees
 - c. Travel Insurance

 - e. Laundry
 - f. Excess Baggage Charges
 - g. Beverages
 - h. Room Service
 - i. Gratuities to driver, tour leaders, and others
 - j. Tips to hotel porters and
 - k. All payments of a personal or like nature
- Special request and payment from customer will be indicated in the tour/booking form.

Child Fare

Children below twelve (12) years as on the date of return is eligible for child fare. Child fare is based on sharing a room with two (2) adults. There will be an additional cost for a child sharing one room with an adult.

Infant Fare

Infant below twenty four (24) months as on the date of return is eligible for infant fare.

Pricing Policy Relating To Promotions

We do accord discounts and other form of promotional pricing. Hence it is our policy to display all service charges including such discounts or promotions.

Payment Scheme for Reservations

Payment can be made in full or by way of a deposit followed by the balance of payment. Please refer to Section 3 for further elaboration.

The Company and its associates act only as an agent for the transportation companies, hotels and other principals for the Company's programmes. As such, the Company and its associates accept no responsibilities for injuries, damage, accident, loss, delay, theft, quarantine, customs regulations, strike changes in itinerary, deportation, or refusal of entry by Immigration Authorities resulting from improper travel documents, possession of unlawful items or irregularities that may be caused to person or property. Any losses and expenses incurred are the responsibility of the Customer. Please note that possession of proper and valid documents is the sole responsibility of the Customer. The Company reserves the right to alter itineraries, travel arrangements, hotel arrangements etc. if it is deemed necessary or in the event of force majeure.

The Company reserves the right to require any individual to withdraw from the tour if his/her act of conduct is deemed detrimental to or incompatible with the interest, harmony and welfare of other tour members and the tour as a whole. The Company shall be under no further liability thereafter to any such individual. No tour leaders/guides or other employee or agents of the Company are authorized to commit the Company to any liability whatsoever and the Company will not be bound by any statement or representation unless in writing and signed by a management executive of the Company.

The Company reserves the right to take photographs and films of Customers while on tour with the company to be used for brochures advertising or publicity materials. Written consent will be sought from the Customer for use of such materials in publications and any other form of advertising.
